

Call for Submissions

The Measure: A Journal of Undergraduate Research is published once a year and distributed each September. Future volumes will accept research from each fall and spring for the following year's publication, with rolling deadlines each semester. Submissions for volume 7 should be completed in CHSS courses during Fall 2022 or Spring 2023 (Academic Year 2022-2023). For example, researched projects from Fall 2022 should be submitted for publication consideration by Friday, January 27, 2023. Spring 2023 projects should be submitted by Friday, May 26, 2023. Accepted papers from the 2022-2023 academic year will be published and distributed in September 2023.

In order for papers to be considered for publication, they must adhere to the following requirements:

- Papers should be double-spaced, 12-point Times New Roman font, with numbered pages. A cover sheet with the author's name, student ID number(s), and contact information for the lead author should be included. No identifying information should appear within the text of the submission.
- All papers should use the citation format appropriate to the discipline in which it was created (e.g., Chicago style, MLA, APA, etc.).
- Research papers should be approximately 3,000 words, and submitted as Microsoft Word files (.doc or .docx).
- Research posters can be submitted as either a PowerPoint slide or a Word file. Research posters must also include a full critical introduction of approximately 1,000 words.
- Authors are expected to use copyright-free images and materials
